What is Engineering?



Engineering is the application of science and mathematics to design, build, and maintain structures, machines, systems, and processes that solve real-world problems.



Computer Science

Software, AI, data science, cybersecurity, and web development



Mechanical

Machines, thermal systems, automotive, manufacturing & robotics



Electrical

Power systems, circuits, electronics, and renewable energy



Civil

Buildings, bridges, roads, water supply & infrastructure



Electronics & Comm.

Communication systems, VLSI, signal processing & IoT



Chemical

Petrochemicals, pharmaceuticals, food processing & materials

Typical Timeline

JEE Main: January & April sessions
JEE Advanced: May | GATE: February
BITSAT: May-June | State CETs: April-May



Key Numbers (2025)

JEE Main: ~12 lakh applicants
JEE Advanced: ~2.5 lakh applicants
GATE: ~8 lakh applicants

Eligibility Criteria



JEE Main (B.Tech/B.E.)

- Passed 10+2 or equivalent examination
- Must have Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics (PCM)
- Minimum 75% marks in 12th (65% for SC/ST/PwD) or top 20 percentile
- No upper age limit (since 2019)



GATE (M.Tech)

- Bachelor's degree in Engineering/Technology (4 years) or MCA
- Final year students can also apply
- No minimum percentage required to appear
- No age limit — working professionals can apply



BITSAT

- Passed 10+2 with PCM and English
- Minimum 75% aggregate in PCM (60% in each subject)

Note: Eligibility criteria may change. Always check the official website for the latest updates before applying.

Age Limit & Number of Attempts

Exam	Age Limit	Number of Attempts	Category Relaxation
JEE Main	No upper age limit (since 2019)	3 consecutive years (2022-2024 for 2022 aspirants)	SC/ST/PwD: 3 additional years (but now continuous)
JEE Advanced	Born on or after Oct 1, 1999 (for 2024)	2 attempts in consecutive years	SC/ST/PwD: 5 years relaxation in age
GATE	No age limit	No limit on number of attempts	Open to all graduates and final year students
BITSAT	No specific age limit	2 attempts per year	Must meet 12th year criteria



UPSC-Style Exam Pattern (JEE / GATE)

JEE Main Pattern

Subject	Questions	Marks
Physics	30 (20+10*)	100
Chemistry	30 (20+10*)	100
Mathematics	30 (20+10*)	100
Total	90	300

* 10 numerical-based (mandatory). Duration: 3 hours. Negative marking: -1 for MCQs.

GATE Pattern

Section	Questions	Marks
General Aptitude	10	15
Core Subject	55	85
Total	65	100

Duration: 3 hours. Types: MCQs, MSQs (no negative), NATs (numerical). Negative marking only for MCQs.

Exam Structure: Written (Pen & Paper / CBT) → No descriptive section → Merit based on rank/score

Unlike UPSC, engineering exams have no interview round for admission — selection is purely rank-based through centralized counseling.

Application / Admission Process

1

Register Online

Visit the official exam website (jeemain.nta.ac.in, gate.iitb.ac.in, etc.). Create an account with email & mobile.



2

Fill Application Form

Enter personal details, academic qualifications, upload photo & signature as per specifications.

3

Pay Examination Fee

Pay online via UPI/Net Banking/Card. General: ₹1000 (JEE Main). SC/ST/PwD: ₹500 (concessional).



4

Download Admit Card

Admit card released 2-3 weeks before the exam. Download from official portal with login credentials.

5

Appear for Exam

Take the CBT exam at your assigned center. Carry admit card + valid photo ID. Follow exam-day guidelines.



6

Counseling & Seat Allotment

Based on rank, participate in JoSAA/CSAB counseling. Fill choices, get seat allotted, report to college.

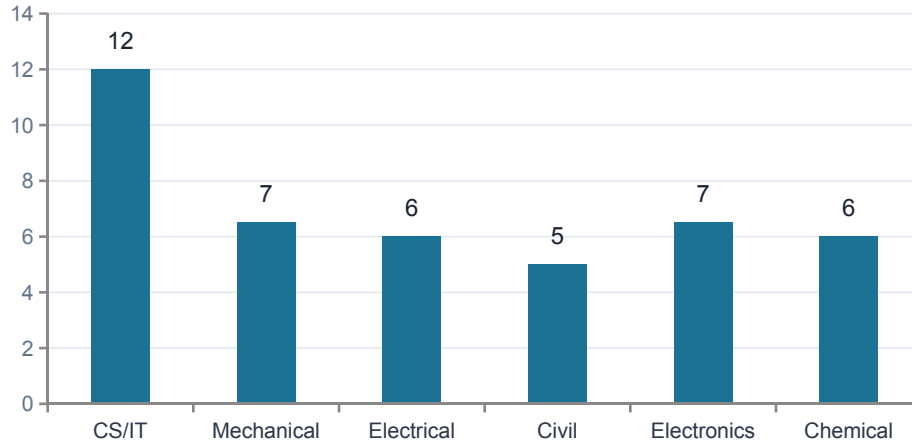

Success Tips & FAQs



Success Tips

- Build strong fundamentals in PCM from Class 11 itself
- Solve previous year papers — at least 10 years of JEE Main
- Take regular mock tests and analyze mistakes
- Focus on NCERT — especially for Chemistry
- Make short notes for quick revision in the last month
- Balance speed & accuracy — don't guess in MCQs
- Stay consistent — 6-8 hours of focused study daily
- Join a test series for competition-level practice



Frequently Asked Questions

Is coaching necessary for JEE?

Not mandatory, but helpful. Self-study with online resources can also crack JEE.

Can I get into IIT without coaching?

Yes! Many toppers are self-made. Focus on concepts, practice & consistency.

What if I don't get into IIT/NIT?

Many top private colleges (BITS, VIT) and state colleges offer excellent placements.

Is engineering still a good career?

Absolutely. CS/IT salaries are at an all-time high. Core branches also offer great growth with specialization.

Can I switch branches after 1 year?

Some IITs/NITs allow branch change based on 1st-year CGPA. Check institute rules.
